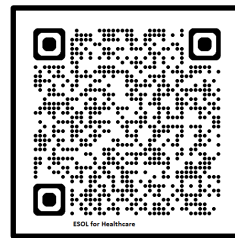
3. **Placement testing will be on the same day.**
