TED009: Grammar & Linguistics Skills for an Integrated Approach to Adult ESOL (prerequisite: TED 001)

Eligibility Requirements

- A minimum of a Bachelor's degree from either a school in the U.S. or country of origin.
- Willingness to commit to completing four, noncredit, 40-hour courses that require attendance in all classes, effort and participation.
- Willingness to independently research a location for the classroom observation requirement in each course.
- A strong commitment to engage in challenging academic work.
- Commitment to completing each course earning a grade of "B" or higher.
